

Rice Farmers in BRIA VIET NAM



BRIA Viet Nam aims to improve livelihood of farmers through developing rice production system toward sustainable ecology and enhance linkage with high quality product in three provinces in the Mekong Delta. A baseline study was conducted by interviewing 300 farmers from one cooperative and six farmer groups in 3 provinces of Dong Thap, Hau Giang and Kien Giang in 2015.



Through capacity building, training and outreach activities, BRIA aims to reach **3,000 out of around 1,365,000*** rice farmers in Mekong Delta (9,000,000 rice farmers in Vietnam)

97.5% of farmers in Dong Thap and Kien Giang sell paddy to free trader (local collector)

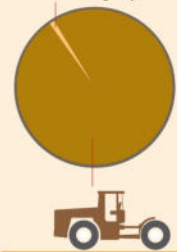


Only 13.7% of farmers are younger than 35 years
